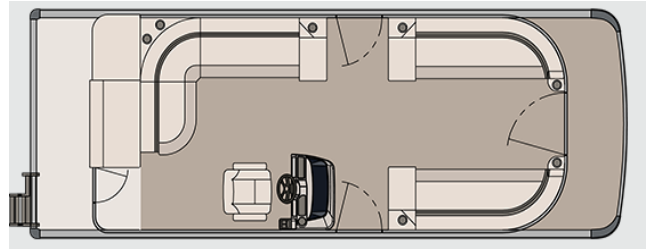
The following bullets apply to all rental boats unless otherwise specified under the individual boat description.

- Closed Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Ask us about our special.
- We provide basic safety equipment; Life vests, whistle/horn, a #4 throwable device, and a fire extinguisher.
- All boats come equipped with a tow ring.
- We do NOT rent water toys (tubes, water skis, wakeboard, kneeboards).
- The exact boat may or may not be available. Like model will be available.
- All boats come with a full tank of fuel. You pay for the fuel used upon return.
- Holiday rates include an additional fee per day and dates are specified by the marina.

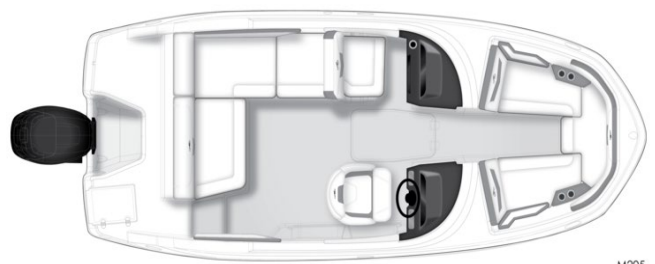

F.A.Q

Do I need a special license to operate the boat? No, a valid state driver's license is all you need.

Who is allowed to drive the boat? Renters as well as boat operators must be at least 25 years of age and have a valid driver's license.

Do I have to wear a life jacket? By law, children 12 years old or younger must wear a life jacket at all times.

Do I need to put down a deposit? No deposit is required above the price of the rental but please be aware that the full amount of the rental is due at the time of booking.

What do I need to bring with me? Please see our rental essentials list below to assist you with all of your rental needs.

Are pets allowed? Yes, we do allow pets aboard but please be aware that you are responsible for any messes your pets make including excessive pet hair.

Can I fish from the boat? Yes, we do allow fishing from our pontoon and fishing boat rentals.

Do I need a fishing license and do you sell them? A fishing license is required if you plan on fishing. We do not sell fishing licenses however you can obtain one at a local bait shop, Wal-Mart or you can purchase one directly from the DNR website online.

Which Credit Cards do you accept? We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover.

Is fuel included in the cost? Each rental leaves the dock with a full tank of fuel. Upon return we will refill the fuel tank and the renter is responsible for the amount consumed.

On average, how much fuel does the boat use? It is nearly impossible to quote an average consumption because there are so many variables to consider (usage, weight, water conditions, wind speed, etc.). A conservative average would be about 5 gallons per hour of engine time.

Rental Essentials

- A Credit Cards, Bug Spray, Sunscreen, Cooler, Ice, Towels, Hats, Sunglasses, Light Jacket (depending on the season), Chap stick, Trash bag for clean-up, paper towels, plates and silverware if you plan to eat on board, snacks, fishing poles and fishing license, Change of clothes
- Infant Life Vests if you are able as our supply can be limited
- Ski Vests if you are looking to Ski or Tube
- Tubes, Skis and Rope
